Aakanksha Lions Institute of Learning And Empowerment (ALILE), run by Lions Club Raipur Sewa Samiti was started on 2nd October 1994 with just 14 children with intellectual disabilities and two qualifies professionals.

Presently we render services to 240 CWSN at Urban & Rural Special School, 110 at OPD, 122 CWSN-deafblind and 25 CWSN-VI with 82 professionals including Special Educators and supporting staff.

BARRIER FREE INFRASTRUCTURE



All the centre based services in Raipur are functional in a barrier free building with a provision of Smart Classes for both the special children and Student Trainees.

The ground floor comprises of a well equipped OPD Wing with physiotherapy unit, speech therapy unit, remedial unit, multisensory stimulation unit occupational therapy unit, seminar hall, and administrative block.

The first floor comprises of classrooms for Special Education Training Courses and the special school, pre-vocational training centre and Library .

The second and third floor is under construction for expansion of our institute

Vision and future perspectives of ALILE is to generate innovative services, through science and technology digitalisation, developing remote communication strategies and appropriately promoting assistive technologies to all Special children of Chhattisgarh and neighbouring States.

FIRST IN STATE OF CHHATTISGARH



- Aakanksha is the only and first NGO to run OPD services -early intervention, speech therapy, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, remedial teaching, rural intervention services, vocational training, parent's training, psychological testing and counseling.
- Aakanksha is the first NGO to collaborate with National Trust in 2002 as State Nodal Agency Centre for CG.
- Aakanksha is the first NGO to get associated with Sense International India as State Learning Centre for Deafblindness from 2005 to 2015. Till date Aakanksha is Nodal Agency for East Zone, working as DbRC which includes-East UP, Bihar, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Odisha and West Bengal.
- Aakanksha is fortunate to have Late Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, Past President of India as Chief Guest to Inaugurate our new premises of Aakanksha on 22nd November 2010
